In word work, we are practicing the ch, th, wh, and sh sounds. Students will continue to review these sounds and patterns in different ways.

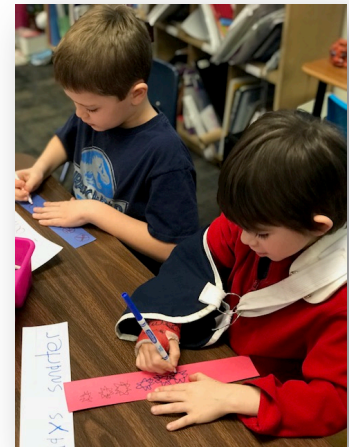
In our book clubs, students have been walking through their
